PRESS STATEMENT

Maldives Police Service is committed to maintain safety and security of all citizens. To this end, we would like to draw the attention of all to our efforts in monitoring the use of helmets while driving on the roads.

Article 19 of Regulation No. 2021/R-131, states that it is mandatory for both the driver and passenger to wear helmets while driving A1 and A0 category vehicles in areas where road vehicles are permitted to travel at speeds exceeding 30 km/h. Speed limit signs are displayed in these areas.

In addition, it has come to our attention that there has been a spike in violent crimes where individuals are donning helmets to veil their identity in areas where the use of helmets is not required by law. Hence, our officers will stay vigilant and proactively stop and search individuals who are suspicious .

Maldives Police Service assures our commitment in bestowing protection and peace within our community.
